Julie Vaughan-Graham PT, M.Sc; graduated from St. Thomas' Hospital, London, England in 1986. Julie has worked in the area of neurorehabilitation since 1988, and has a special interest in the rehabilitation of the incomplete spinal cord injured individual. Julie emigrated to Toronto in 1991, initially taking a position at Lyndhurst, Spinal Cord Injury Centre, and then later opening her own private community neurorehabilitation practice, Physiologic, in Toronto in 1993.

Julie qualified as an IBITA Bobath Instructor in 2000, and as an Advanced IBITA Bobath Instructor in 2008. Julie graduated from Leeds Metropolitan University, UK in May 2010, with a distinction for her M.Sc. dissertation on 'Clinical Reasoning and the Expert Bobath Therapist'.

Julie was accepted into the PhD program, Graduate Department of Rehabilitation Science, University of Toronto, in September 2011, and maintains a lecturer status with the Department of Physical Therapy.

Course Description:

This is a 15 day course instructed over 4 week-ends. It is comprised of instructor led clinical learning sessions, which include utilizing lectures, practical sessions, patient demonstrations and patient treatment sessions. During the intervening period between w/e's 3 & 4 the course participants complete a guided self-directed case report. Certification is dependent upon successful completion of the case report.

Course participants will be instructed in the Bobath Concept problem solving approach to assessment, treatment and management of adult neurological conditions. Emphasis will be placed on practical application of contemporary research findings in order to promote evidence-informed practice. Course participants will have the opportunity work with a variety of diagnoses including CVA, ABI & iSCI, at various stages of recovery. This course has a practical emphasis to develop handling skills.

Course Objectives:

Course participants will be able to:

- 1) Understand the history & current theoretical rationale of the contemporary Bobath Concept.
- 2) Observe & analyze human movement and function, and influence this through intervention.
- 3) Utilize contemporary principles of motor control, motor learning, and neuromuscular plasticity in their approach to treatment, consistent with "evidence based practice".
- 4) Understand the relationship between assessment & treatment, and implement the ongoing process of clinical reasoning.
- 5) Develop effective handling skills and incorporate them with environmental and other influences in order to regain function
