Julie has worked in the area of neurorehabilitation since 1988, and has a special interest in the rehabilitation of the incomplete spinal cord injured individual. Julie emigrated to Toronto in 1991, initially taking a position at Lyndhurst, Spinal Cord Injury Centre, and then later opening her own private community neurorehabilitation practice, Physio-Logic, in Toronto in 1993. Julie qualified as an IBITA Bobath Instructor in 2000 and as an Advanced IBITA Bobath Instructor in 2008. Julie is currently enrolled in an M.Sc. 'The Bobath concept' at Leeds Metropolitan University, Leeds, UK, and is in her final year completing her dissertation on 'Clinical Reasoning and the Expert Bobath Therapist'. Julie maintains a clinical caseload at her private practice in Toronto, and provides one on one clinical mentorship on a consult basis to physiotherapists and occupational therapists. Julie has a Status-only Instructor status with the University of Toronto. She instructs post-graduate clinical Bobath courses across Canada and Internationally.

**Course Objectives:**

At the completion of the course the participant shall be able to:

1. Recognize the importance of a problem solving approach in the assessment and treatment of movement dysfunction.
2. Begin to observe and analyze human movement with reference to base of support, alignment, selective movement with respect to activity performance.
3. To develop an understanding of balance with respect to predictive and reactive postural control strategies.
4. Appreciate the influence of sensory information on motor output through an experience of facilitated movement.
5. Begin to describe the relationship of neural and musculoskeletal plasticity to patient potential.

The participant will be introduced to the analysis of movement on normal subjects as a basis for discussing the assessment and treatment of deviations of posture and selective movement. The information shared in this 3-day course is based on the Bobath Concept. The course will be largely practical with some formal lecture and informal discussion.
